The download you received is a copy of an original document held by The National Archives, London, England, in the collection of the High Court of Admiralty (HCA). This document is one of many records giving proof of early modern transmaritime and transcontinental entanglements. It survived due to the navel powers' common practice of prize taking in times of war.

The digital representation of the archival record and the describing metadata were produced by the Prize Papers Project, and presented by the project's online portal to the collection www.prizepapers.de.

The aim of the Academies Programme is to retrieve and explore European cultural heritage, to make it accessible in and highlight its relevance to the present, and to preserve it for the future.

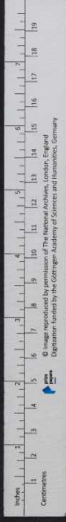
